

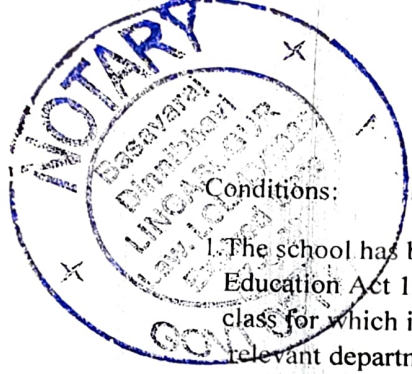

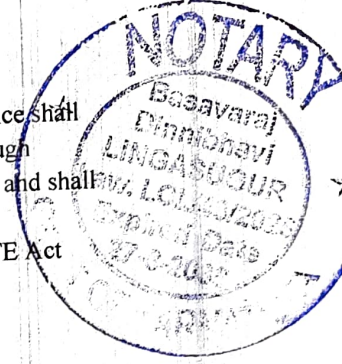


Conditions:

1. The school has been registered under the Child Rights Education Act 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the rules made there under, and the recognition has been renewed up to the class for which it was registered. Apart from these classes, additional classes and the permission of the relevant departments are not given.
2. This School has been working under the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and Children's Right to Education act 2009.
3. The Child Rights Education Act 2009, under the rules made there under, shall reserve 25% of the seats for the weaker sections of the society. The government shall have the power to enroll the reserved seats in schools falling under the RTE. (The government has made rules to facilitate the enrollment of children in schools near the residence of their parents, and accordingly, if there are government or government-aided educational institutions, the children will be enrolled in that school.) In case there are none, private schools shall admit the children enrolled by the government and allow them to continue their education up to the primary level. These children shall be allowed to continue their studies without any discrimination.
4. As explained in Section 3, the Government shall waive the fees of the children enrolled under the RTE Act as per the rules. Therefore, it is prohibited to collect any fees from these children.
5. The school and the school management prohibit the collection of any capitation fees and Voluntary donations from parents either at the time of registration or later.
6. The school/management shall publish the information on the fees charged by the parents of the children in their school's notice board and also in SATS according to RTE act section 2B. No fee shall be charged in excess of the prescribed fee.
7. The school/management board shall enroll students within the period specified by the government.
8. The school/management shall not deny admission against the following factors.
 - (i) Due to lack of proof of age.
 - (ii) On the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language.
 - (iii) If entry is requested after an extended period of time in the area.
9. All safety measures are to be taken as per RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules. (Fire safety and building safety certificate from concerned authorities and safety of children's learning as per K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R).
10. School management has to be follows:
 - (i) No child admitted to the school shall be held in any class or expelled from the school until he/she completes his/her primary and secondary education.
 - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical or mental abuse.
 - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination until the completion of primary education.
 - (iv) Every child who completes primary education will be issued a certificate as prescribed under Rule 21 of the RTE and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 - (v) The school should also include children with special needs/special needs as per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 - (vi) The appointed teachers shall possess the minimum educational qualifications as prescribed for primary and secondary school teachers in the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education

- Act and Rules and Government Orders.
- (vii) The salary and allowances payable to the teachers and the terms and conditions of service shall be as prescribed by the State Government. The salary shall be paid to the teachers through Government Notification (Provident Fund (PF)) and other salaries payable by the bank and shall be covered by the Employee State Insurance (ESI).
- (viii) Teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section 24[1] of the Act and the RTE Act and Rules and Rule 17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for supervisory considerations.



11. The school's affiliated with state board shall follow the state text books and state board syllabus.
12. The school shall maintain the rules and norms as specified in Section 19 of the Karnataka Education Act and should appoint the teachers according to act.
13. The school buildings and other infrastructure related to the school shall not be used for any commercial activities or political and non educational for both day and night.
14. The school should not be run for the profit of any individual or group or association.
15. The school will get an audit done by a chartered accountant and a copy will be submitted to the Deputy Director/Field Education Officer by the end of June every year.
16. The school follows a language policy according to Government Notification Kannada Language Policy -2016
17. The governing body and teachers will act in accordance with the RTE Act and the Karnataka Education Act and rules.
18. The school/board of directors shall strictly follow the rules and directives of the government and the department.
19. It is mandatory to upload S.A.T.S. school information as per the rules by the end of March of each year.
20. In case of violation of the above conditions, the school's recognition will be cancelled as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
21. After the school accreditation process is completed, the entire document information in the application submitted online by the governing body will be made publicly available on the departmental website.
22. In case of violation of the above conditions, the school's recognition will be cancelled as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
23. Renew safety certificates and lease deed documents obtained from competent authority and upload them mandatorily in SATS within one month of their expiry.
